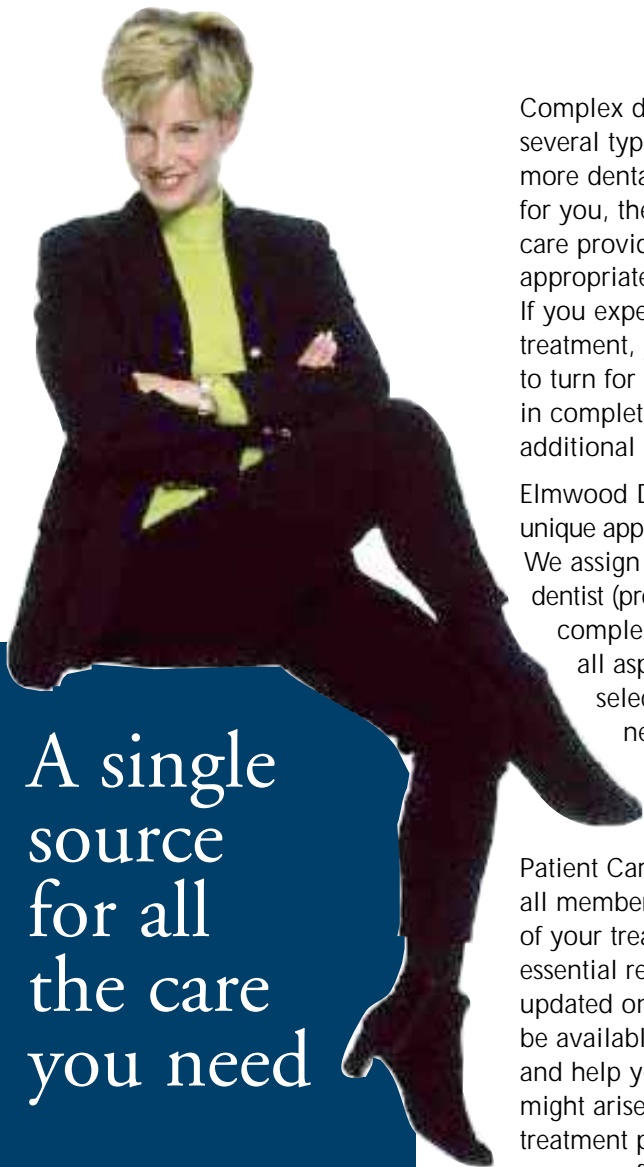
There's no reason to live with intermittent or chronic dental pain. We can determine the cause of your discomfort and solve the problem.

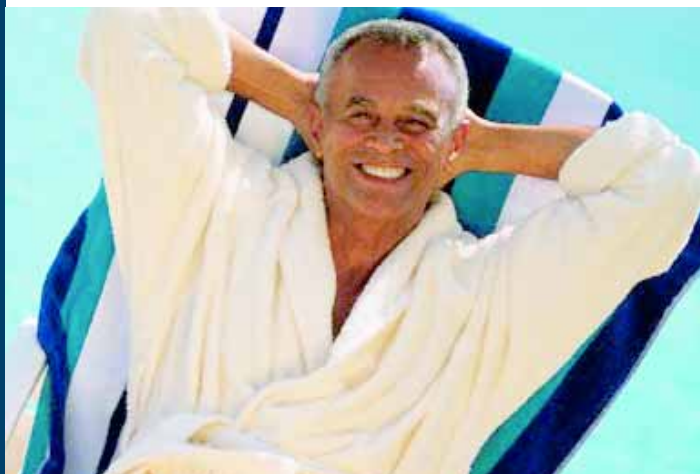

Complex dental problems often require several types of treatment from one or more dental specialists. It can be difficult for you, the patient, to select the best care providers and determine the appropriate sequence of treatment steps. If you experience any problems during treatment, you may not know where to turn for help. This can lead to delays in completion of your treatment and/or additional expense.

Elmwood Dental Restoration Center's unique approach eliminates these problems. We assign a Patient Care Coordinator, a dentist (prosthodontist) trained in resolving complex dental problems, to oversee all aspects of your treatment. He will select the best specialists for your needs, work with the team to develop your treatment plan and monitor your progress throughout treatment. Your

Patient Care Coordinator will ensure that all members of your team receive copies of your treatment plan, x-rays and other essential records, and he will keep them updated on your progress. He will always be available to answer your questions and help you resolve any problems that might arise. If changes in your overall treatment plan or schedule become necessary for any reason, your Patient Care Coordinator will handle the arrangements and notify all members of the team.



Six steps to comfort and confidence

Step 1: Defining your goals

Your Patient Care Coordinator will meet with you to discuss your chief concerns, your goals and your desired treatment timetable. He will also take your dental and medical history information.

Step 2: Examination, evaluation and analysis

Your Patient Care Coordinator will do an oral examination, take digital “before” photos and order panoramic x-rays, radiographs and/or other tests. This will allow your Patient Care Coordinator to assess the condition of your gums, teeth, roots and underlying bone structure and recommend the best course of treatment for you.

Step 3: Diagnostic work-up

Your Patient Care Coordinator will produce a detailed treatment plan including all components and the sequence of steps necessary to achieve your goals. Your individual treatment plan may include a range of dental services, such as:

- Cosmetic dentistry
- Dental implants
- Crowns and/or bridgework
- Oral rehabilitation
- Oral surgery
- Gum surgery
- Full or partial dentures
- Orthodontics
- Endodontics

Your individual treatment plan will also include models and/or digital “after” photos showing how you will look upon completion of treatment.

Step 4: Solutions consultation

Your Patient Care Coordinator will meet with you to explain your individual treatment plan and the team of specialists selected for your care. He will review your “before” and “after” models/photos to confirm that the treatment plan fully addresses your objectives. He will help you evaluate options and decide the best course of treatment for your goals, your timetable and your budget. He will also tell you about financing options available to help you manage the cost of treatment. You will have the opportunity to ask questions, and you will leave knowing exactly how many appointments will be needed to complete your care.





Step 5: Treatment

Depending on your specific needs, your treatment plan may include appointments at Elmwood Dental Restoration Center and appointments at the offices of one or more partner specialists. Regardless of where you're being treated, however, your Patient Care Coordinator at Elmwood Dental Restoration Center will monitor your progress and be available to answer questions and help you resolve any problems that might arise. He will ensure that all members of your treatment team are apprised of your progress and fully informed of issues pertaining to your care.

Step 6: Aftercare

Upon completion of your treatment, we will show you how to care for your beautiful new smile and, if appropriate, recommend appliances or products to help keep your teeth healthy. We will give you a schedule for follow-up appointments, if necessary, and offer you the option of electronic appointment reminders. We will also ask you to fill out a Patient Satisfaction Questionnaire to ensure that we have fulfilled your treatment goals and provided a positive dental care experience.

Q. Will my dental insurance cover my treatment?

A. Depending on your individual treatment plan and the type of dental insurance you have, some of your treatment may be covered. We will determine your insurance coverage and explain it fully during your solutions consultation.

Q. Can I arrange to pay for treatment over time?

A. Yes. We accept most credit cards, and we can make financing programs available to patients. We can also phase your treatment plan to help you take best advantage of insurance coverage and/or financing options.

Q. How will you select the dentists in my treatment team?

A. We work only with the best dental specialists, so you can rest assured that every member of your treatment team is highly skilled in his or her specialty. We begin by determining the type(s) of care you need, then select the team best qualified to meet your needs and most convenient to you.

Q. How long will my treatment take?

A. Treatment may take from a few weeks to several months, depending on your needs and scheduling preferences.
